HS:7—Acts of the Apostles—Q/A

- 1) This follower of Jesus wept outside his tomb, and was the first to see the resurrected Lord.
- 2) This disciple of Jesus was elected as the 12th apostle to join the others after the death of Judas Iscariot.
- 3) This man, the first Christian martyr, was stoned to death while Saul, a well-respected Pharisee, watched with approval.
- 4) This apostle, son of Zebedee and brother of John, was martyred by sword on the order of Herod Agrippa.
- 5) At this Ecumenical council, held in 50 A.D. it was decided that Gentile converts to Christianity did not need to be circumcised.
- 6) Paul traveled to Rome after his second missionary journey so he could do this.
- 7) Shortly after his resurrection, two of Jesus's disciples met him on the road to this town, but at first failed to recognize him.
- 8) This man donated the tomb he had prepared for himself as a burial place for Jesus.
- 9) When the risen Jesus appeared to the Apostles at the Sea of Galilee, he repeated this instruction to Peter three times.
- 10) This term describes Jesus's instruction to his apostles to "teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost."
- 11) Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from this earthly location.

- 12) About this many people in Jerusalem witnessed the works of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and were baptized as Christians by the apostles.
- 13) This disciple from Cyprus welcomed Paul to Jerusalem, introduced him to Peter and accompanied Paul on his first missionary journey.
- 14) After preaching in Samaria, this apostle met a man from Ethiopia who was reading the Hebrew scriptures, and baptized him.
- 15) A great persecution against the Christians of Jerusalem began after the trial and martyrdom of this disciple.
- 16) This Roman centurion's prayers and almsgiving were so pleasing to God, he sent an Angel to instruct him to go to Simon Peter and be baptized.
- 17) The sin of selling or selling Church offices is named after this Magician from Samaria, who offered Peter money for the power to work miracles.
- 18) This city, where Paul and Barnabas began their missionary journey, was one of the most important centers of early Christian evangelism.
- 19) While imprisoned in chains in Philippi, Paul and Silas were set free from prison in this way.
- 20) While on their second missionary journey, Paul and Silas were beaten and thrown in jail in this Macedonian city.
- 21) The Apostle Paul chose this disciple to accompany him on his second missionary journey.
- 22) When the Paul and Silas returned to Lystra in Asia Minor, they were joined by this fellow missionary, who accompanied them to Macedonia.
- 23) While he was imprisoned in Caesarea, Paul was allowed to make his case for Christianity to this Jewish leader, and nearly converted him.
- 24) After the apostles Paul was shipwrecked during his voyage to Rome, he and the boat's crew washed ashore on this Island.
