TF:1— God, Creation, and Fall —Q/A

The primary reference for the following questions is Chief Truths of the Faith by Fr. John Laux (1932), Section II, chapters 1-8. Similar material is covered in most Student Catechisms.

- 1) This is the briefest and most ancient of all Catholic professions of faith.

- 2) This is one of the twelve sections that the Apostles creed is divided into, each describing a particular truth of the faith.

- 3) This term, based on the Latin word for 'I believe', is a summary of the chief truths of the Christian faith.

- 4) At a council held in 325, this creed was established to define Catholic orthodoxy and combat the Arian heresy.

- 5) This is the meaning of the term "omniscient."

- 6) The attributes of God can be divided into qualities describing these three aspects of God.

- 7) These two attributes of the Divine Nature describe the fact that God is not limited in either time or space.

- 8) These perfections of God assure us that God rewards good and punishes evil, while willingly pardoning repentant sinners.

- 9) This is the special guidance given by the Holy Spirit to human authors that allowed them to write Sacred scriptures according to God's intention.

- 10) This is the union of the faithful on earth, the blessed in heaven, and the souls in purgatory, with Christ as their head.

- 11) This is the end for which man was created by God.

- 12) The existence of Hell and the reality of eternal suffering offer us proof of this perfection of God.
- 13) Besides suffering physical torments, suffers in hell will suffer pain of loss due to this.
- 14) We will face this at the end of our lives, when our body and soul are separated.
- 15) The Latin term "ex nihilo", describing how God created the world, means this.
- 16) This is the manner in which God preserves and governs his creation.
- 17) This is the clear and immediate vision and experience of God enjoyed by the angels and saints in heaven.
- 18) The word Angel comes from the Latin word meaning this.
- 19) These are the three archangels specifically named in the Bible.
- 20) This is the rite performed by a priest whereby evil spirits are driven out of a person's body in the name of Christ.
- 21) This is the meaning of the name Lucifer.
- 22) This is the leader of the fallen angels. He is one of the seven princes of Hell, associated with the sin of Pride.
- 23) This demon is one of the seven princes of hell, associated with material wealth and the sin of Avarice.
- 24) This part of man is made in the image of God.
