## TF:2— Grace and Redemption —Q/A

*The primary reference for the following questions is Chief Truths of the Faith by Fr. John Laux (1932), Section II, chapters 9-20. Similar material is covered in most Student Catechisms.*

- 1) These three Old Testament characters prefigure the role of Jesus Christ as a sacrificial offering.
  
- 2) These are the meanings of the words Jesus and Christ.
  
- 3) This describes the hypostatic union of Jesus Christ's God and Human Natures.
  
- 4) St. Margaret Mary Alacoque established the practice of dedicating this day to devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
  
- 5) This was Mary's reply when the Angel Gabriel requested that she bear the Son of God.
  
- 6) This holy day of obligation, celebrated August 15th, honors the death and resurrection of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
  
- 7) Jesus' death on the cross showed that these two perfections of God are not opposed to each other, but perfectly fulfilled.
  
- 8) This is the reason Jesus descended into Hades immediately after his crucifixion?
  
- 9) This name, meaning "the anointed one" reflects the Old Testament custom of anointing kings and priests to consecrate them.
  
- 10) In his role as Christ the King, Jesus does this.
  
- 11) These are the three roles of Jesus Christ as leader of his Church.

- 12) The final verses of the Gospel of Matthew, where in Jesus tells his apostles to "make disciples of all nations . . . " is known as this.
- 13) This term refers to the authority to lay down the authentic teaching of the Catholic Church.
- 14) When Jesus delegated the authority of his three-fold office (prophet, priest, king) to his apostles, he commissioned them to perform these tasks.
- 15) When the Holy Ghost descended on the apostles at Pentecost, it appeared visibly in this form.
- 16) This process begins with the unmerited grace of God which touches a sinner's heart and calls him to repentance.
- 17) This is an unmerited gift from God to his rational creatures that allows them to partake in a supernatural life in the presence of God.
- 18) This is temporary help from the Holy Spirit, which tells us what God expects at a certain moment.
- 19) This Protestant theologian claimed God unconditionally predestined some men to salvation and others to eternal damnation.
- 20) This parable demonstrates that God gives some men more grace than others, but offers sufficient grace to all men to work out their salvation.
- 21) In this Parable, Jesus makes it clear that good works should follow from true faith, and that faith without works is dead.
- 22) These are the cardinal vices that we combat by prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.
- 23) The Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin is a holy day of obligation and is celebrated on this date.
- 24) By this mystery, the virgin Mary was preserved from the guilt of original sin.
