

WT:3— Marian Devotions —Q/A

- 1) The Latin hymn "Magnificat", based on Mary's speech to the Angel Gabriel, is also known by this title.
- 2) Catholics believe that this condition existed of Mary before and after the birth of Jesus.
- 3) This term refers to the Blessed Virgin's role as an intercessor and mediator in Christ's saving work of redemption
- 4) This Marian apparition occurred in Portugal during WWI and requested consecration of Russia to the Immaculate Heart.
- 5) The Immaculate Heart of Mary, the Servite Order, and the Black Scapular are all associated with this Marian devotion.
- 6) These siblings, along with their cousin Lucy, witnessed six apparitions of our Blessed Mother in Fatima.
- 7) The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to this Indian peasant as Our Lady of Guadalupe and told him to gather roses into his cloak.
- 8) Mary, Joseph, and John the Apostle appeared to over twenty townsmen in this Irish village in 1879.
- 9) This shrine, located in the Diocese of Green Bay, Wisconsin, honors a recognized Marian apparition that was reported in 1859.
- 10)** At Fatima, this miracle occurred and was witnessed by thousands of onlookers.
- 11) In 1905 Pope Pius X established an indulgence for the regular practice of this tribute to the Blessed Virgin.
- 12)** These two months are especially dedicated by Church as times to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary.

- 13) By this mystery, the Virgin Mary was preserved from the guilt of original sin.
- 14) This 5th century heresy denied that Jesus was both God and Man in one person, and claimed Mary was mother only to his human nature.
- 15) This is the date of Solemnity of Mary, formerly the Feast of the Motherhood of the Blessed Virgin.
- 16) This was Mary's reply when the Angel Gabriel requested that she bear the Son of God.
- 17) This is what Mary whispered to the servants at the wedding she attended with Jesus at Cana.
- 18) Church bells traditionally accompanied the call to this prayer in Churches and Monasteries, three times per day.
- 19) The Hail Mary is based on verses spoken by the Angel Gabriel and Mary's cousin Elizabeth, taken from this Gospel.
- 20) This Marian prayer was popularized by Frances de Sales in the 16th century, and is sometimes said following a Rosary.
- 21) This is the Latin name for the 'Hail Holy Queen' prayer, often prayed at the close of a Rosary.
- 22) This sacramental was designed by Catherine Laboure after the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to her in a vision in 1830.
- 23) This is a common name for the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, in use at least since the 15th century.
- 24) Pope Pius V designated Oct 7 as a feast day honoring the Blessed Virgin to commemorate her assistance at the Battle of Lepanto.
